(Psalm 103:7).

Access to the treasures of heaven belongs to them that care to know God's way. If you will not miss out on God's best for your life; you will need to go beyond knowing God's act and get to know God's way. Read the account of a widow that was lifted by God from zero level to an enviable pedestal of abundance in 1 Kings 17:8-24.

From the story of the Widow at Zarephath and several others in the Bible, it is very clear that when God is ready to bless a life, he first and foremost gives an assignment to that person to carry out. Obedience in carrying out the assignment and diligence in doing it well will then provoke God to bless such a life beyond imagination.

### Get to Know God's Ways

There are several ways by which God could have provided food for Prophet Elijah. He had earlier commanded the ravens to take care of Elijah's meal.

## When GOD is Ready TO BLESS YOUR LIFE

Assuming the ravens got tired, God could have picked the dove or any other bird to take over the responsibility. In His infinite wisdom however, God shifted the responsibility of Elijah's feeding to the widow at Zarephath. This was because God was ready to bless the widow.

*"But I tell you of a truth, many widows were in Israel in the days of Elias, when the heaven was shut up three years and six months, when great famine was throughout all the land; But unto none of them was Elias sent, save unto Sarephath, a city of Sidon, unto a woman that was a widow"* (Luke 4:25-26, KJV).

I am happy the widow did not miss the divine opportunity given to her by God to be blessed and be divinely lifted. She could have dodged that assignment for several reasons. She could have queried the Man of God whether he knew she was a widow. She could have even accused God of partiality. After all there were several wealthy women in the land, if compulsorily the prophet must be catered for by a woman. The widow's question could have been: Why me? What a woman of understanding!

I feel sad, however, looking around and seeing several people today dodging the opportunities that could have taken them out of their miry clay. The unchangeable God in His unchanging method of blessing lives, still keep giving responsibilities to people with the intention of making that to become a point of contact for the ceaseless flow of the blessing and the grace of God into their lives. This is the point at which many (who could have become something for God) miss it. You will not miss it in Jesus' Name.

### Follow God's Way!

The widow at Zarephath trusted God with the little she had and God proved Himself to be the best Manager of resources. Your income may be "a handful of meal in a barrel plus a little oil in a cruse" (1 Kings 17:12) and yet God is demanding that you support missionary work. If you obey, God will manage your resources for you and it shall come to pass that "the barrel of meal shall not waste, neither shall the cruse of oil fail, until the day that the Lord sends rain upon the earth," (1 Kings 17:14).

# The Gathering Of The EAGLES

The TLC (Touching Lives @ Christmas) International Leadership Retreat began on Friday, 24<sup>th</sup> June 2022 when over 340 Christian brothers and sisters from Ghana, Benin Republic, Cameroon and Nigeria congregated at the Youth Camp, Eyenkorin, Kwara State, Nigeria. The purpose of the 3-day event which ended on Sunday, 26<sup>th</sup> June was to provide an open forum for fellowship, worship, practical discussions, testimonies of God's faithfulness, intercessions, meetings, connections, personal prayers and reflections, trainings (and graduations), counselling, capacity building and lots more. From the messages: "The Gospel Light Will Continue to Shine," "You Are Commanded To Shine," to "Be Empowered To Shine On," the theme of **SHINING ON** permeated the retreat. Indeed, the use of light as a guidepost served three important functions: First, the gospel light will continue to shine because it's a divine verdict confirmed with an oath (Isaiah 14:24, 27). Second, to shine is a God-given identity, a God-given command, a God-given strategy, a battle against the light and an assurance of victory. Third, the shining of

those who advance the Kingdom of Christ through soul winning and turn many to righteousness lasts through eternity. What great benefits!

In his message to the teeming believers who thronged the city of Ilorin for a special time of fellowship with God and like-minded individuals, the International Director of The Kingdom Projects, Pastor Olusola Adebayo, highlighted the significance of the Word of God and the work the Holy Spirit does to endow believers with fresh oil and power to keep the fire burning. Hence, by refocusing on certain priorities that are critical to progressive shining such as committed attention to prayers, consistent addition of the wood of the word of God and application for power over and over again, believers can set themselves up for continual shining.

There is no doubt that the reality confronting many Christians is the tendency to allow their shine to dim. However, God's children were reminded in that power-packed program that shining is a covenant issue. And to enjoy the covenant of shining on in this Dark Age, every child of God should "be sure of their relationship with Christ; maintain intimacy

In Liberia the brethren ministered to souls especially in the rural areas. They put smiles on many faces through welfare outreach and a warm atmosphere of worship.

Like Apostle Paul, the three-man team that stayed behind didn't go to sleep. They ministered, prayed for the sick, had a film show and strengthened the local church in Comekro village.
